



DO NOT POUR PAINT THINNER DOWN SINK OR TOILET!

Paint thinner destroys plastic plumbing.

Paint thinner contaminates the water supply.

Suggestions: how to work with paint thinner using jar systems

Use 3 jars to clean your brushes.

Use jar #1 for the first dip. This jar will be the dirtiest. Move to jar #2 and then jar #3, the cleanest and last. Continue to reuse the same thinner over and over.

OR

Use 2 or 3 jars with paint thinner, using one at a time.

As you use one jar, the other jar(s) will have time for the paint pigment to settle to the bottom. Reuse these jars over and over.

To clean your thinner, let particles of pigment settle to bottom. Pour off clear thinner.

Disposing of paint thinner.

Most waste haulers won't accept liquid paint thinner. Small amounts of it can be hardened by leaving container open in safe place outside. Bring hardened crystals to Hazardous Waste center.
